- Your spouse did not live in your home during the last 6 months. Your spouse is considered to live in your home even if he or she is temporarily absent due to special circumstances. **Please include a utility bill for both parents showing separate addresses.**
- Your home was the main home of your child, stepchild, or foster child for more than half the year.
- You must be able to claim an exemption for the child. However, you meet this test if you cannot claim the exemption only because the non-custodial parent can claim the child.

- You were married but considered "Unmarried" on December 31, 2015 (IF you initialed ALL of the previous criteria, initial here.)
- You paid more than half of the cost of keeping up your home for the 2015 tax year.
- A qualifying person lived with you in the home for more than half the year (except for temporary absences, such as school). However, if the "qualifying person" is your dependent parent, he or she does not have to live with you.

Please note: If you incorrectly marked your FAFSA as "Head of Household," you will need to order an IRS tax transcript to verify your filing status.
